On August 23, 2010, Jeffrey Lanning of CenturyLink, Michael Shultz of Consolidated Communications, and I spoke via telephone with Angela Kronenberg of Commissioner Mignon Clyburn's office.

ITTA urged the Commission to implement measures that address phantom traffic, access stimulation, and obligations of VoIP providers to pay access for calls terminated on the public switched telephone network (PSTN). Immediate action on these items will reduce incentives for arbitrage, strengthen provider stability by enabling proper cost recovery, and serve as a reasoned prelude to further comprehensive reform.
