On July 29, 2010, Jeffrey Lanning of CenturyLink and I met with Lynn Engledow, John Hunter, and Albert Lewis of the Wireline Competition Bureau to discuss the above-captioned proceedings. Robert DeBroux and TDS Telecom and Pat Morse of FairPoint Communications joined the meeting via telephone.

ITTA urged the Commission to implement measures to address phantom traffic, access stimulation, and obligations of VoIP providers to pay access for calls terminated on the public switched telephone network (PSTN). Immediate action on these items will reduce incentives for arbitrage, strengthen provider stability by enabling proper cost recovery, and serve as a reasoned prelude to further comprehensive reform.
