(Washington) The following statement regarding passage today by the U.S. House of Representatives of S.J. Res 34 was released by ITTA - The Voice of America's Broadband Providers and may be attributed to Genny Morelli, President of ITTA:

"ITTA commends the House for passage of S.J. Res 34, a resolution of disapproval nullifying the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC") unnecessarily restrictive and destructive broadband privacy rules adopted last year under FCC Chairman Wheeler. S.J. Res 34 would return us to an environment in which broadband consumers receive consistent and uniform protection of the privacy of their personal information from all entities in the Internet ecosystem. ITTA urges President Trump to immediately sign S.J. Res 34 into law."
